The Neighbourhood Response Team was introduced in April 2006. Doncaster is the only area in the country to have a team like this and it has proved to be extremely successful in tackling anti-social behaviour and low level crime across the Borough.

The Neighbourhood Response Team operates seven nights a week from 7pm to 6am. (except Bank Holidays)

The Neighbourhood Response Team can assist with:

- Gangs of youths
- Anti-Social Behaviour
- Street Drinking
- Noise Complaints
- Fly Tipping, Abandoned Cars and Graffiti
- Street Lighting
- Assisting other public services such as South Yorkshire Police
- Plus many more

If you have a problem on a night and do not know who to call, contact the Neighbourhood Response Team who will be happy to provide advice and assistance where possible in relation to your problem.
