Are you a sufferer of violence or domestic abuse? Do you want to stay living in your own home and feel safe? The Doncaster Sanctuary Scheme can help to make your home more secure and provide ongoing support from specialist organisations.

● What is Sanctuary?

The purpose of the Sanctuary Scheme is to help sufferers of domestic violence and victims of hate crime to remain in their own homes and feel safe whilst receiving ongoing support from specialist organisations.

A Sanctuary room is a room in your home, usually the main bedroom, which is made secure. This can be done in different ways using various security measures.

Every Sanctuary Scheme is tailored to accommodate the needs and circumstances of the individuals involved.

The police and fire service will be made aware that Sanctuary measures have been installed in your home, so they will know how best to help you in an emergency situation.

● How do I access the Sanctuary Scheme?

If you live in Doncaster and are experiencing domestic violence or harassment you may be eligible for the scheme. Access to the Sanctuary Scheme is done through a risk assessment of the victim's circumstances.
